

ICITSM 2026 – Author Guidelines

1. Manuscript Preparation

- Manuscripts must be written in English.
- Submit papers in Microsoft Word (.doc/.docx) using the official ICITSM 2026 template.
- Do not modify page size, margins, fonts, or heading styles provided in the template.

2. Paper Length

- Full Paper: 6–10 pages.
- The manuscript should be complete and ready for peer review.

3. Paper Structure

- Title
- Author Name(s)
- Affiliation(s)
- Corresponding Author Email
- Abstract (150–250 words)
- Keywords (4–6)
- Introduction
- Related Work/Literature Review
- Proposed Methodology
- Experimental Results and Discussion
- Conclusion
- Conflict of Interest (if applicable)
- Acknowledgement (Optional)
- References

4. Title

- Use a concise and informative title.
- Avoid abbreviations where possible.

5. Author Details

- Full Name (Don't use Dr, Mr, Ms, Mrs, Prof, Smt)
- Department
- Institution
- City
- Country
- **Email Address* (For all authors)**

- Clearly identify the corresponding author.

6. Abstract

- Research problem
- Objective
- Methodology
- Results
- Conclusion
- Length: 150–250 words

7. Keywords

- Provide 4–6 keywords immediately after the abstract.
- Example: Artificial Intelligence, Machine Learning, IoT, Deep Learning, Explainable AI

8. Headings

- INTRODUCTION
- RELATED WORK
- METHODOLOGY
- RESULTS AND DISCUSSION
- CONCLUSION
- REFERENCES

9. Figures

- Minimum 300 dpi.
- Number consecutively.
- Caption below each figure.
- Cite every figure in the text also.

10. Tables

- Number consecutively.
- Caption above each table.
- Cite every table in the manuscript.

11. Equations

- Using Editable equations format.
- Number consecutively.

12. References

- Cite all references in text sequential order only allowed.
- Provide complete bibliographic information.
- Prefer recent references.
- Use the template reference style.

13. Originality

- Original research only.
- No plagiarism.
- No duplicate submission.
- Proper citation of borrowed material.

14. Camera-Ready Paper

- Revise according to reviewer comments.
- Submit final manuscript before deadline.
- Complete copyright form if required.
- Register for the conference.

15. Presentation

- At least one author must register and present the accepted paper.

16. Publication

- Accepted and presented papers meeting editorial, quality, and ethical standards will be considered for publication in the Bentham Science Conference Proceedings, subject to final publisher approval.

17. Submission Checklist

- Paper in English
- Abstract (150–250 words)
- 4–6 Keywords
- High-resolution figures
- Tables numbered
- References complete
- All citations included
- Plagiarism-free
- Corresponding author details provided
